Job Summary: The SWTX Campus Police Officer enforces state and local laws, Rules and Regulations established by SWTX's College Board of Trustees and oversees that all law and order is maintained and accomplished. The SWTX Campus Police is assigned to implement and execute appropriate measures to prevent crime, protect the campus and secure the public safety of SWTX. Campus Police work closely with the College's leadership, and all academic, administrative and service units of SWTX. Campus Police must show excellence in verbal and written communications, strategic planning, and ability to foster a positive work environment, honesty, integrity, and ethical conduct. Performs routine Patrols on campus or campuses, check security of buildings, and investigate complaints. Campus Police enforce Texas Criminal laws and SWTX Policies, complete necessary reports and possess the ability to communicate effectively with students and college personnel. College Police maintain hours established by the college as assigned by immediate Supervisor/Vice President. Campus Police follow required rules, regulations, and safety procedures as outlined in the college employee handbook. Performs all other functions as assigned by immediate Supervisor/Vice President when the need arises for efficient operation of the college.

A Texas Driver's License, a Texas Peace Officer License, authorized to work in the U.S. and provide verifiable credentials. Also, successful completion of the reference and background check specified for the position. Travel required to other geographic locations served by the college and be insurable through SWTX insurers. Security-sensitive position.

Additional Qualification Requirements: Ability and skill to manage a high volume of work are necessary. Must be able to demonstrate experience working effectively with individuals from diverse backgrounds. Must have excellent English, writing, and oral communication skills. Must possess required knowledge, skills, abilities, and experience and be able to explain and demonstrate, with or without reasonable accommodation, the essential functions of the job. The candidate must be authorized to work in the U.S., provide verifiable credentials, and successfully complete the background checks specified for the position. Must have a valid driver's license and be insurable through SWTX insurers. Travel is required to other locations served by the college.
